Dear Guest,

Grand Canyon Expeditions (GCE) is committed to your health and safety on our expeditions. Although this commitment is always of the utmost importance to us, we are taking extra precautions during this global pandemic. We are closely monitoring state and federal guidelines and following the recommendations of Grand Canyon National Park.

We are strongly encouraging guests who are in a vulnerable population to reschedule their trip until they are fully vaccinated. Vulnerable populations include, but are not limited to people with the following conditions:

1. Over 65 years of age
2. Chronic lung disease or moderate to severe asthma
3. Severely obese
4. Diabetes, chronic kidney disease, or undergoing dialysis
5. Liver disease
6. Other immunocompromised individuals (HIV, undergoing cancer treatment, or other underlying medical conditions)

If you are a part of a vulnerable population, please contact our office to discuss your options.

For guests that are coming on the river this year we have some new guidelines in place. They are detailed in our COVID-19 Mitigation Plan which is available on our [website](#). We are including guidelines below that you should understand before you travel for your trip.

We strongly recommend that you utilize good hygiene practices during travel to the trip. Good hygiene practices include but are not limited to:

- Wearing a mask when unable to maintain physical distancing of 6 feet.
- Washing hands often and especially before eating or preparing food, after blowing your nose, after touching your face, after coughing or sneezing and after using the toilet
- Hand sanitizer should be carried and used when hand washing is not available

While on the trip GCE encourages all employees and guests to take personal responsibility for practicing physical distancing. It is important to note that due to the nature of these trips there will be times when it is not possible to distance yourself 6 feet away from other persons that do not reside in your household. Everyone is



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encouraged to obtain as much physical distance as possible at these times. Employees and guests are also encouraged to use face masks when appropriate, practice good hand-washing hygiene, avoiding touching the face, and sneezing or coughing into the inside of the elbow.

There is a screening questionnaire attached to this letter. Please fill out the questionnaire before traveling for your trip. A separate screening questionnaire should be filled out for each person in your party. Bring the signed questionnaire to your orientation meeting. If you don't have a questionnaire for each person in your party, they will need to be filled out and signed before entering the orientation meeting room. Please note the criteria that would prevent someone from being allowed on the trip. If you develop symptoms prior to traveling for your trip please contact our office to discuss your options.

Please contact our office with any concerns or questions that you might have. We are looking forward to a great season and are excited to have you on the river with us!

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Grand Canyon Expeditions COVID-19 Screening Form

1. Have you recently experienced any of the following symptoms?
 - Fever (100.4°F/ 38°C or higher) or chills?
 - Cough that you cannot attribute to another health condition?
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing that you cannot attribute to another health condition?
 - Sore throat that you cannot attribute to another health condition?
 - Muscle aches that you cannot attribute to another health condition, or that may have been caused by a specific activity (such as physical exercise)?
 - Loss of taste or smell?

2. Have you been in contact with an individual who has been ill with flu-like symptoms in the last 14 days?

3. Have you been diagnosed with COVID-19 in the last 30 days? If yes, please enter the date you were notified that you were no longer contagious with COVID-19.

4. Have you ever been tested for COVID-19? If yes, when was the test and what were the results?

5. Have you been tested for COVID-19 antibodies? If yes, what were the results?

6. Are you fully vaccinated against COVID-19? When was your last vaccination received?

If you answered yes to the first two questions, you will not be allowed on the trip. If you answered yes to the third question, please submit a note from a medical professional that states that you are well enough to travel and are no longer contagious with COVID-19.

You will be rescreened and have your temperature taken at the orientation and each day of the trip. If you develop symptoms prior to the launch of the trip, you and your immediate family will not be allowed on the trip.
